BRIEF PROFILE OF BRINDA K VARMA

Brinda K. Varma is an Advocate and Patent Attorney with over 15 years of experience in various arenas of law. Her area of practice spans around wide spectrum and largely focuses on dealing with intellectual property rights (IPR) including patents and trademarks, consumer disputes, women and child rights. She is associated with research wings of several institutes to frame their IPR strategies. She is the managing partner of Aekam Legal, a law firm based out of Bangalore, which handles and assists research entities and businesses including start-up's in various legal matters from inception of a company to protecting their IPR. Apart from having a wide litigation base and clientele, she has also carved a niche for the firm in advising, policy drafting and execution of various contracts for research organisations and start-ups including, IP policy, sexual harassment policy, HR policy etc.

She is associated with various reputed academic and R&D organisations such as Indian Institute of Science, IISER- TVM, IISER-Pune, CMTI etc as their IP consultant/ legal counsel. She handles technology transfer deals for IISc inventions, drafting and negotiating research and license agreements. She was instrumental in transforming the IP cell of IISc from a service facilitator to a service provider. She was involved in handling several research based collaborations with industries. She worked towards pursuing a systematic, mutually-beneficial engagement with research-based national and international companies in order to encourage them to partner with IISc.

Dr. Brinda holds a PhD from NLSIU Bangalore, a master's degree in Biochemistry and Biotechnology and an LLB degree from Bangalore University. She also holds a Post-graduation degree in Business Administration from Symbiosis, Pune. She is a registered Indian Patent Agent and qualified to practice before the Indian Patent office. She is a regular speaker at various forums and organisations and has delivered talks across the country in various fields of law. She is also involved in corporate training in the fields of IPR, commercial laws, contracts and consumer related laws for various entities such as IIM, DRDO, IISER, L&T, CMTI etc. Also, she is associated with Visvesvaraya Trade Promotion Centre (VTPC), and KSCST(Karnataka state counsel for science & technology), Govt. of Karnataka, as an IPR and legal consultant. She regularly appears before the Karnataka High Court, City Civil Courts, Family Courts, Consumer Forums and Administrative Tribunals.

Report on An Awareness Program on Intellectual Property Rights

The Human Rights Protection Cell 2024–25, in association with the IQAC, the **Department of Political Science, and the Department of Computer Applications (BCA),** organized a one-day workshop on April 23, 2025, at Akkamahadevi Seminar Hall, Sree Siddaganga College of Arts, Science, and Commerce for Women, Tumkur.

The event commenced with an invocation by Mrs.Nanditha, a student of II B.Com, setting a reverent tone for the program. A warm welcome address was delivered by the convenor **Smt. Pavana B.S**, Head of the Department of Political Science. This was followed by an introduction of the guest by Ms. Mounika B from the Department of Computer Science. The resource person for the session, Dr. Brinda K. Varma, a distinguished advocate, delivered an enlightening talk on human rights protection, engaging the audience with her deep insights. Dr. Sheela K.P, Head of the Department of English and IQAC Coordinator, addressed the gathering and emphasized the importance of such initiatives.

The presidential address was delivered by **Dr. H.M. Dakshinamurthy**, Principal of SSASCW, Tumkur, who highlighted the significance of human rights awareness among students. The program concluded with a heartfelt vote of thanks by Ms. Nandini A.O. from the Department of Political Science. The entire event was seamlessly hosted by Mrs. Amulya J. from the Department of Computer Science, who served as the Master of Ceremony.

An awareness program on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) was conducted by the Human Rights Protection Cell in association with the Department of Political Science and BCA. The session aimed to educate students and faculty about the importance, scope, and practical applications of IPR in today's competitive world.

The guest speaker for the event was **Brinda K. Varma**, a distinguished advocate and patent attorney. She delivered an insightful lecture that provided a comprehensive overview of IPR and its role in fostering innovation and protecting creative works.

Ms. Varma began by explaining that intellectual property is the creation of the mind, which includes inventions, literary and artistic works, designs, symbols, names, and images used in commerce. She emphasised the importance of safeguarding these creations through various forms of intellectual property rights.:

Copyrights: Protection for literary and artistic works such as books, movies, paintings, and cinematography. It generally lasts for the life of the author plus 60 years. Trademarks: Identifiers such as logos and brand names that distinguish products or services. Trademarks can include anything from a college's name to a product label. Designs: Protection of the aesthetic aspects of products, especially industrial designs, which are typically protected for 10 years. Patents: Exclusive rights for inventions, usually granted for a period of 20 years. Plant Variety Protection: Aimed at encouraging innovation in agriculture, especially beneficial for farmers. Trade Secrets: Confidential business information that provides a competitive edge. Semiconductor Designs and Industrial Applications: Including microchip and motherboard designs.

The speaker also highlighted the types of IPR and the importance of authenticity and legal approvals. She connected IPR to real-life examples, including inventions like the iPhone and iPad, and local products such as Nandini (milk and milk products).

A significant part of the session focused on IPR as a business tool. Ms. Varma urged the audience to view IPR not just as legal protection but as a strategic asset in a competitive environment involving technology, business, and law. She stressed the need for market evaluation of an invention—its buyer, value, and uniqueness—and the legal responsibilities of small businesses. She also advised considering the investor's viewpoint when assessing intellectual property.

The lecture concluded with a powerful message on the necessity of IPR in today's global economy, reinforcing how crucial it is for innovators and entrepreneurs to understand and protect their intellectual creations.




