#### Field Visit Report-Department of Botany and Microbiology

As part of the Tumkur University academic curriculum, the Department of Botany and Microbiology organized a one-day educational field visit to Central Food Technological Research Institute (CFTRI) and participated in world Food Safety day with I, II, and III B.Sc. students (BZ, BBt, CB, ZMb, CMb, MBt combinations) on 10 June 2025. A total of 39 students and 3 faculty members participated in this experiential learning programme.

The visit aimed to enhancestudentsunderstandingofbiodiversity,ecologicalinteractions, food safety and modern food processing technologies.

#### 1. Visit to Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary

The first part of the day was spent at Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary, a renowned ecological hotspot near Srirangapatna. Students observed a wide variety of resident and migratory birds.

#### 2. Educational Visit to CSIR-Central Food Technological Research Institute(CFTRI), Mysuru:

In the afternoon, the team visited CSIR-CFTRI, one of India's premier research institutes in food science and technology. The visit was organized as part of World Food Safety Day, celebrated on 10 June 2025.

Scientists interacted with students, answered queries and explained current research and industrial applications. This exposure greatly enhanced students understanding of laboratory practices and the importance of food safety in public health.

All students actively engaged in discussions, demonstrations, note-taking, and observation tasks. They adhered to institutional guidelines and represented the college with discipline and enthusiasm throughout the visit.

The students gained practical exposure beyond text book knowledge.


