International Day for Biosphere Reserves

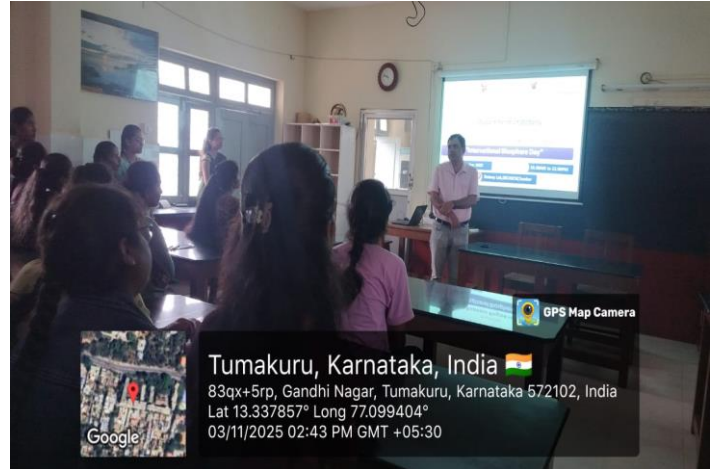


WORLD BIOSPHERE DAY
